**Subject: Mandatory Implementation of the E2M Automated Export Declaration System for all Commercial Air Shipments**

In connection with CMO 49-2010 "Electronic Lodgment of Export Declarations through Value Added Service Providers at the One Stop Export Documentation Center" and CMO 54-2010 "Electronic Lodgment of Export Declarations through Accredited Value Added Service Providers, supplemented by CMO 7-2012 "Supplemental Guidelines in the Implementation of the Automated Export Documentation System under e2M Customs", it is hereby ordered that for air exportations transacted and loaded through the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA), Diosdado Macapagal International Airport (DMIA), Mactan-Cebu International Airport (MCIA) and Davao International Airport (DIA), the implementation shall initially cover **commercial shipments only**.

As defined, Commercial Shipments are trade commodities/items for sale or barter under consignment with commercial value or quantity. These are regular exports wherein the exporter and importer of goods are business entities.

The following are exempted from this implementation:

1. All Personal Effects shipments which shall continue to be processed manually.
2. All shipments emanating from the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA) and Freeport Zone Authority (CDC, AFAB and SBMA) which shall be covered by a separate Customs Memorandum Order (CMO).

All rules and regulations inconsistent with this Order are hereby deemed repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

This Order shall take effect 15 days after approval.
